3. Pledge Allegiance to The Flag

4. Special Presentations:
Jerry Huskey requested that it be noted on the agenda if there were no special presentations to be heard.
5. Approval of July 18th, 2019 Meeting Minutes
Rachel Huskey made a motion to approve the July 18th meeting minutes, seconded by Kevin Howard. All Ayes. Minutes approved.
6. Citizens Comments
Mayor Huskey reminded those in attendance that Resolution No. 219 was now in effect and that no one had submitted a request to address the board.

7. Chief of Police Report

Chief Parton reported that the highway section from Cosby to Pittman Center limits has been lowered 5 mile an hour, changing from 55mph to 50mph prior to entering into Pittman Center City limits.

A fourth police officer has been hired. Officer Ben Ogle will begin his career with the Town of Pittman Center Police Department on August 26, 2019.

8. Town Administrator Report

Michael Borders stated that he will be meeting with Jim Booher next week (the week of the 19th) in regards to the town's audit.

The bank statements that were inadvertently placed in the packet this time would probably continue to be sent to the board for full transparency.

Michael Borders will give an update on the future Pittman Center paving when he has more information.

10. New Business:


